



Letter from YIS Founder & President, James Fletcher, CFA



Young Investors Society achieved another great year! It's amazing to look back and see that our program has now grown to 1,825 schools in 75 countries! I'm thrilled to see the snowball continue to grow for high school students across the world.

Many things stand out to me from the accomplishments for YIS this year. One is the expansion of the Global Stock Pitch Competition format. This year, held in Salt Lake City, we were able to more than double the amount of teams that we hosted onsite, and we added more workshops, speakers, and an onsite Case Study Competition. It was huge success, and the kids and parents loved the expanded format. It was also exciting to see teams fly in from all over the world to compete, including teams from Canada, United Kingdom, Colombia, South Korea, and China.

Another achievement of Young Investors Society this year was the continued growth of the Access Initiative program, which serves underserved communities. We grew from 167 to 221 schools, as we continue to expand our Access Partners. This would not be possible without the support of key strategic corporate sponsors that signed up to support the Access Initiative on a multi-year basis, Bloomberg Philanthropies and Gradeur Peak Global Advisors. We are grateful to their ongoing support and belief in the mission of YIS to "Provide Financial Literacy To All".

I am always amazed at every opportunity I have to interact with the amazing YIS kids! This year I had the opportunity to teach an eight week MasterClass and was truly inspired by the kids that participated in the class. Also during the stock pitches, the Investment Symposiums, the CYIA interviews, and all of the many interactions during the year with the YIS kids, I'm continuously reminded that the future is bright and that investors can truly change the world!

Young Investors Society has met 100% of the membership and program goals for the year including exceeding our total schools goal as well as Dollar-A-Day Challenge and fundraising goals for the year.

We are beginning to see the impact of our growth with the largest Global Stock Pitch Competition to date as well as an increase in the Access Initiative. We can proudly announce that 20% of our total students are served through the Access Initiative. I can proudly say that we are positioned for a future where every high school student has access to FREE, quality, online financial education.

We started off the year offering an 8-week Investing MasterClass taught by James Fletcher which quickly filled to capacity with 50 eager students. We have had great feedback from the students that they thoroughly enjoyed this course offering.

We successfully held an online Giving Tuesday Fundraising Campaign and the first Change the World 5K Charity Run on the West Coast to support YIS programs. We were also able to secure multi-year corporate sponsorships from Bloomberg Philanthropy and Grandeur Peak to support the Access Initiative. We were amazed at the generosity and support from our YIS Boards and donors as well as local businesses and corporate sponsors.



Understanding Impact on Youth

A study by the US Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) analyzed census data from 2008 and found that household income dramatically impacts youth outcomes. Youth from low-income families are more likely to be teen mothers, engage in gang activity and delinquent behaviors, and are less likely to graduate from a 4-year college than are youth from middle-income and high-income families.

YIS Access Initiative Goals

The YIS Access initiative provides access to FREE, quality, financial literacy education, diverse mentors, STEM career education, and scholarships to a variety of talented students in underserved communities.

Objectives:

- Increase access to financial literacy programs to under-resourced communities.
- Expose students to a variety of careers available in financial markets and STEM disciplines via mentorship programs.
- Raise awareness that financial market and STEM opportunities are available to students regardless of gender, race, or socio-economic status.
- Enable students to apply observational, practical, modeling, inquiry, and problem-solving skills in finance related coursework.



120 students were selected to receive the Dollar-A-Day FREE Money Match Scholarship for the 2022-2023 school year.

YIS Shark Tank Contest



YIS Global Stock Pitch Workshops & Case Study Competition







This year, the YIS Global Stock Pitch Workshops were hosted by Bloomberg, Goldman Sachs, Grandeur Peak Global Advisors, and First Community Bank. Students rotated through 4 workshops that covered Identifying Investments, Public Equity vs Private Equity, ESG Investing and What is Your Why?

YIS also hosted it's first Case Study Competition and the winning team won \$500 cash plus a paid internship!

YIS Access Initiative





The YIS Access Initiative achieved a school growth of 32% this year serving 221 schools and over 1,600 students across 35 states.

The YIS Access Initiative currently serves 20% of total YIS students via afterschool program partners, school clubs, and individuals.

The YIS Access Initiative received the Money Awareness & Inclusion Award in 2022 for the Best Project for Underserved Communities.

Change the World 5K Charity Run




