How to become a YIS Community Champion?

1. Build a team of friends and family that can help and support you with collecting canned and non-perishable goods.
2. Contact your local food bank or food pantry to see what items are most needed and collection dates, times, drop off locations, etc.
3. Collect canned/non-perishable goods December 1st-February 28th.
4. Ask parents, friends, and family to sponsor your food drive for the amount of food collected. (example: \$1.00 per pound of food collected) Sponsorships will go directly to support the YIS Access Initiative which provides free, quality, financial literacy education and programs to schools in under-resourced communities.
5. Update your social media page weekly with pictures, videos, and updates on your food collection.
6. Complete the Food Drive Donation Form and send to Ctobin@yis.org no later than **March 30, 2024**.
